2d. Mission Committee

The Mission Committee is responsible for directing Plymouth's international mission efforts. Our purpose is to educate and inspire the members of Plymouth to reach beyond our own congregational life. The chairperson, or a designee, also serves as a member of the Church Council.

Timely publicity is the principal focus of the Committee's efforts in promoting its projects and many fund raisers in support of the United Church of Christ and Church World Service. The committee's bulletin board is maintained in the Fellowship Hall, and notices are routinely placed in the Placard and also the Sunday Bulletins.

This committee promotes and/or conducts several annual fund raisers and programs/projects, some of which currently include:

Additionally, the committee coordinates and arranges missionary visits to our church through the UCC's Rocky Mountain Conference and/or Global Ministries, as opportunities arise.
