

2f. Evangelism Committee

Formed in 1994, the purpose of the Evangelism Committee is to envision and implement a program designed to share the Evangel or "good news" of God's generous love in Jesus Christ with people in our community. The intent of this program is to attract new persons to Plymouth, invite them to consider membership and assist them in becoming involved in the life of the congregation.

As defined in the Plymouth constitution, the committee consists of 8 members each serving 2-year terms, with a chairperson chosen by committee.

Meetings are held monthly, except in summer.

Responsibilities:

- Prepare nametags for members and friends and encourage people to wear their nametags on Sundays.
- Socialize with Sunday morning visitors who are drinking from navy blue cups
- Deliver loaves of Great Harvest bread to 1st-time Sunday morning visitors who sign Friendship books
- Collect Friendship books at the end of Sunday morning services
- Prepare and make available "Get Involved" brochures
- Share the "good news" of God's love and Jesus Christ's life with visitors and friends (and of course, members too)
- Sponsor "Bring a Friend to Church" Sunday
