The Rev. Marta Fioriti is our candidate to become our next settled associate minister. We are thrilled to introduce you to her.

Marta most recently served as Pastor of Black Forest Community Church, UCC, very near to La Foret. Prior to that she served as Minister for Faith Formation at the Broadmoor Community Church, UCC, and Director of Youth and Adult Ministries at First Congregational UCC, both in Colorado Springs. She is a 2015 graduate of the Iliff School of Theology, and she has returned to Iliff to participate in their Doctor of Ministry Program, which she is now completing.

Marta created and co-hosts a podcast, *Jesus Has Left the Building*, which began during the pandemic. Marta served on the board of directors of La Foret, where she worked with Plymouth member Larry McCulloch and Hal Chorpenning.
