DONATION WISH LIST

KITCHEN

Microwave safe dishes: plates (large and small), cups/saucers, cereal/soup bowls

Microwave ovens!

Mugs, glassware - all sizes/types

Serving pieces (platters, large bowls, etc.)

Cooking items: skillets, saucepans, woks, soup pots, baking pans, oven-safe casserole dishes, etc.
